Every autumn, boys and girls in schools across the country take part in **FoodAid** to raise money for **Concern Worldwide's** work in Africa and Asia.

**Concern** work with the poorest people to make sure they will always have enough food.

We are hoping to raise money for **FoodAid** in three ways this year:

## Walk for Water

A sponsored walk will take place on **Monday 12th October at 1.45pm** on the **Pavilion Field**, just down the road from our school. You are welcome to come and watch or even take part.

Each child will need their coat and sturdy shoes/boots/wellies. It would also be good if each child could bring a plastic bucket (labelled with their name) to simulate carrying water over a distance (the younger ones will carry empty buckets).

**Class 1** will be aiming for one lap of the field.

**Classes 2 and 3:** two laps.

**Classes 4 and 6:** three laps.

Should the weather be against us, the walk will take place on **Tuesday 13th October** at 1.45pm.

Please note: Children should not go knocking on people's doors for sponsorship.
